Where are the records?

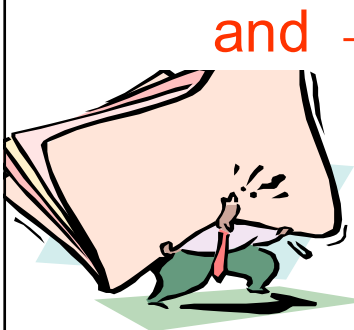
